Memorandum of Understanding

between the Federal Government of Austria and the United Nations on the Extension and Amendment of the Memorandum of Understanding between the Federal Government of Austria and the United Nations for the Loan of Prison Staff to the International Criminal Tribunal for the former Yugoslavia

In accordance with Article VIII of the Memorandum of Understanding between the Federal Government of Austria and the United Nations for the Loan of Prison Staff to the International Criminal Tribunal for the former Yugoslavia, signed on 4 November 1998, as amended on 21 May 1999, 19 May 2000, 31 May 2001, 27 May 2002, 8 July 2003 and 27 May 2004 ("Memorandum of Understanding"), the Memorandum of Understanding is hereby extended for a further period of twelve months, from 1 June 2005 until 31 May 2006, on the same terms and conditions.

In accordance with Article IX of the Memorandum of Understanding, the following Articles are amended:

Article III shall read as follows:

- 1. The International Tribunal shall pay the Government for the services of the Loaned Personnel, on the basis of EUR 32,168.00 per person per year, pro-rated on a monthly basis, according to the services performed.
- 2. The amount per person shall be adjusted on 1 January 2006. The adjustment shall be made on the basis of the annual price index according to the Consumer Price Index (CPI) All Households (2000=100), published by Statistics Netherlands.
- 3. Payment shall be made in arrears and in two instalments, which shall be due on 30 November 2005 and 31 May 2006, respectively. No additional or further payments shall be due in respect of the Loaned Personnel.

Article VIII shall read as follows:

This Agreement shall enter into force on 1 June 2005, and shall remain in force until 31 May 2006, unless terminated earlier by either Party upon one month's written notice to the other Party. The Agreement may be extended with the consent of both Parties on the same conditions and for a further agreed period.
