

**INSTRUMENT AMENDING THE CONVENTION
FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF
THE EUROPEAN RADIOTRANSMISSIONS OFFICE (ERO)**

The Contracting Parties of the Convention for the Establishment of the European Radiotransmissions Office (ERO) (The Hague, 1993),

considering

that the Council of the European Radiotransmissions Office, at its 14th ordinary meeting, held at Copenhagen, 8-9 April 2002, has adopted amendments to the Convention for the Establishment of the European Radiotransmissions Office (ERO) (The Hague, 1993), in accordance with the relevant provisions of Article 20 of the said Convention,

have agreed as follows:

Article 1

The Convention for the Establishment of the European Radiotransmissions Office (ERO) (The Hague, 1993), hereinafter referred to as "the Convention", is amended and the consolidated version of the text of the Convention, as amended, is annexed to this Instrument.

Article 2

According to the provisions of Article 20 of the Convention, the Convention, as amended, will enter into force for all Contracting Parties on the first day of the third month after the Government of Denmark has notified the Contracting Parties of the receipt of notifications of ratification, acceptance or approval from all Contracting Parties.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the undersigned representatives of the Contracting Parties, having been duly authorised thereto, have signed the present Instrument amending the Convention for the Establishment of the European Radiotransmissions Office (ERO) (The Hague, 1993).
